

Hillsboro Energy Commission Approved Minutes  
May 26<sup>th</sup>, 2022; **Bolded items are things to-do**

Meeting opened at 6:06 PM. Attendance: Brett Cherrington, Chairman; Jon Daley; Adam Charrette, Sue Durling

### Secretary's report:

Minutes from May 12<sup>th</sup>, motion to approve as amended by Sue, seconded by Adam; unanimously approved.

### Delegation

Sue will be in charge of the community power project. Jon will be in charge of the weatherization project. Adam will be in charge of the LED street lighting project. Brett will be in charge of the EV charging station.

### LED Street Lighting Contract

### Electric Vehicle Charging Stations

The Charging Forward virtual meeting happened last week, Brett and Sue attended along with a few key members from the community (business owner, police, building inspector) and a lot of employees from US DOT and Eversource.

The main purpose of the meeting was to inform the town as well as get feedback to help revise the document.

Jessica Wilcox and Mike Tardiff will likely be our key contact people going forward.

Dennis Roberts (of Hillsboro Ford) is not in favor of using the State land near his lot, as he stated he has an agreement with State that allows him to use that land for parking.

Brett brought up the police station lot as well. They were just asking for suggestions of possibilities, and didn't evaluate or compare possibilities because were just collecting data.

Brett talked with the chief after the meeting about having the charging lot out front for the public; the chief definitely wants any charging station for the police cars out in the back, away from the public charging locations.

Brett found a solar car port design that was built using an Energy Efficiency Grant in Delaware that looks pretty interesting.

There was a second meeting (public hearing) by the NH Transportation Council, regarding the NEVI (National Electric Vehicle Infrastructure) that Brett and Sue also attended, and they were asking for possible locations for chargers. The attendees of that meeting were from all over NH talking about why their location was a good location for a charging station.
