## Former Woods Woolen Mill 23-25 West Mill Street, Hillsborough, New Hampshire

The Town of Hillsborough will be conducting a public meeting to coincide with the Board of Selectman meeting, on August 27 at 6 p.m. to review and gather public comments on a Draft Analysis of Brownfields Clean-Up Alternatives (ABCA) and Remedial Action Plan (RAP) document. The ABCA/RAP is being submitted to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and the New Hampshire Department of Environmental Services to conduct cleanup activities at the Former Woods Woolen Mill, located at 23-25 West Mill Street in Hillsborough, NH.

The Former Woods Woolen Mill site operated as a textile mill and railroad from 1880 to the mid-1980s and consisted of seven buildings to support the manufacturing of textiles. The site was subsequently used as a private residence until it was abandoned in the mid-2000s. Remaining cleanup activities consist of a combination of excavation and off-Site disposal of impacted material, the implementation of an Activity and Use Restriction (AUR) and floodplain restoration.
